





Denison State Bank, Main Bank 421 New York Ave Holton, KS 66436



Denison State Bank, founded in 1901, is headquartered in Holton, KS and operates full-service branches in Holton, Hoyt, Meriden and Topeka, plus 8 ATM locations in those areas. On Dec. 31, 2009, the bank reported total assets of \$243 million, putting it in the top 50 largest banks in Kansas out of approximately 380. The bank employs 63 full-time officers and staff, 8 part-time employees, is governed by a 7-member board of directors, and is owned by Denison Bancshares, Inc.

exacqVision Hybrid video management systems and software were installed to help Denison Bank protect customers, employees and assets. The exacqVision systems replaced aging time-lapse VCR's. The exacqVision systems manage 22 analog and 8 IQinvision 3 megapixel IP cameras located throughout 5 bank branches to provide a safe environment in which customers and staff can manage financial assets and transactions. 8 new 3 megapixel cameras were strategically placed in the lobby and behind the tellers to provide high resolution video images on anyone entering the bank. Each branch also has the exacqVision client software installed on the branch managers PC that has access to only those cameras located in their branch. The main branch also has two exacqVision client workstations connect to all 5 branches giving management video surveillance access to all branch cameras for viewing live and recorded video and remote administration. When an incident is reported staff will search digital video on the video servers to investigate and support their findings. Video can be easily exported to a DVD or USB flash drive and may be shown to police. Video evidence helps Denison reduce crime.


